CHARACTER

At Holmleigh Park, we place a premium on the arts, culture, sports, and outdoor learning. We are proud to have received recognition from the Association for Character Education as a school of character, reflecting the impact this has on our students' growth and happiness.

To increase their sense of belonging, students are placed into four houses – Hurricane, Javelin, Meteor and Typhoon, named after four of the aircrafts built by the Gloucester Aircraft Company. Students are able to gain house points each day, and house competitions run throughout the year. In September 2025, we introduced HP Enrichment, an exciting new initiative that embeds extra-curricular clubs directly into the school timetable. This ensures every student has the opportunity to explore new interests, develop skills, and take part in enriching activities as part of their school day. Alongside this, we offer a wide range of trips and visits, from day experiences to residential opportunities in destinations including Belgium, Spain and France, helping to broaden horizons and create lasting memories.

SIXTH FORM

At Holmleigh Park, our Sixth Form represents the pinnacle of the school. The majority of students choose to remain with us for a full seven years, and we welcome applications from students at other schools too.

We offer a wide range of courses, with students choosing either our academic or technical pathway. Both are designed to equip students with all the skills and knowledge to progress on to university or a high quality apprenticeship.
