



UNIFORM

For all Year 7-11 students the uniform is:

- A school blazer and school tie
 - Plain sky blue work-style shirt or blouse – long - or short-sleeved to be tucked in at all times
 - Either tailored black trousers or the school skirt. Trousers should be completely plain black (no large decorative buttons or zips) and tailored. No “fashion” extremes will be tolerated (tight, skinny fit, stretchy, low rise, chinos, jeans, drainpipe, Miss Sixty, linen, leggings or cropped). Trousers should sit comfortably over the laces and not pulled down over them. Skirts will be worn to a length of 2 inches above the knee or longer.
 - Formal and professional plain black shoes – these should be of a material that can be polished. No canvas shoes i.e. ‘dolly shoes’, suede shoes, trainers or military style / doctor martin boots
 - A v-necked jumper can be purchased from our uniform suppliers. This is optional and can be worn under the blazer, but not instead of a blazer
 - Socks must be plain black
 - Tights (no leggings) should be plain black and not patterned. White socks over tights are not permitted
 - During cold/wet weather, students are encouraged to wear an outside, waterproof coat for the journey to and from school and during break time and lunchtime if outside the school buildings. Please note that denim / leather jackets and hoodies are NOT permitted and such items will be confiscated if worn on site.
 - Uniform will be worn correctly at all times
 - Shirts will be tucked in at all times
 - Blazer sleeves will be worn down and not rolled up
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- In cases where medical reasons require a modification to the uniform policy, notice in the form of a letter on headed paper from a medical professional must be addressed to the Headteacher detailing the reason.
 - Notes from parents will not be accepted for missing/forgotten items of uniform or medical dispensations

Uniform can be purchased from the **Trutex Shop in Gloucester**

(The school does have a selection of trousers, blazers, ties and shoes which are all of good quality and will be lent to students if they have incorrect uniform)

To ensure that high standards of uniform are maintained and that the correct uniform is being worn in the correct manner at all times, morning line up will consist of a thorough check of personal appearance. In cases where personal appearance and uniform fails to adhere with the guidelines detailed, students will be sent to OSP until the matter is resolved in full. Prohibited items of clothing will be confiscated on sight. Refusal to remove prohibited items will result in a fixed term exclusion.
