#### APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK

#### CARPENTRY AND JOINERY

- Apprenticeships in **carpentry and joinery** typically last for a duration of three to four years, during which apprentices work alongside professionals to gain hands-on experience. They learn various techniques, skills, and practices while working on site. This allows them to acquire practical skills and knowledge that are essential for a successful career in the field.
- The apprenticeship curriculum covers a wide range of topics, including woodworking fundamentals, building materials, structural design, blueprint reading, measuring and cutting techniques and installation of fixtures and fittings. Apprentices also learn about health and safety regulations, project planning, and teamwork, which are crucial aspects of working in carpentry and joinery.
- Upon completing their apprenticeship, candidates will have the necessary skills to work independently as carpenters and joiners. The demand for skilled carpenters and joiners remains steady, and if they do not continue to work with the Trust this apprenticeship offers a solid foundation for a rewarding and versatile career in the construction industry.
- Apprentices on the Carpentry and Joinery programme will work within Gloucestershire Managed Services, the Trust's sister organisation which manages Estates and Facilities.



#### **CAREER OF THE WEEK**

#### **ARTS THERAPIST**

- A career in **Arts Therapy** combines artistic expression with therapeutic techniques to promote healing, emotional well-being, and personal growth. Arts Therapy is a form of psychotherapy that utilizes various art forms as a means of communication and self-expression. It is a creative and holistic approach to therapy that is used in a wide range of healthcare settings.
- In your role, you would work with individuals or groups, including patients, clients, and their families, who are facing physical, emotional, or psychological challenges. The primary goal is to use art-based interventions to help individuals explore their feelings, enhance self-awareness, improve coping mechanisms, and foster personal growth.
- To become an arts therapist, you'll need to be a graduate .You can then take a postgraduate diploma/Master's programme approved by the Health and Care Professions Council, either full or part-time. Teachers or psychologists who have a commitment to the visual arts may also be considered.
