APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK

HEALTHCARE SCIENCE PRACTITIONER

Apprentices in this program work as trainee **healthcare science practitioners**. They contribute to the diagnosis, treatment, and monitoring of patients in various healthcare specialties, such as clinical physiology, medical physics, and clinical bioinformatics. **Entry requirements** can vary, but apprentices usually need at least five GCSEs (or equivalent) at grade C/4 or above, including English, Maths, and Science. Upon successful completion, apprentices are qualified healthcare science practitioners and can pursue careers in the NHS or private healthcare organisations. They could potentially specialise further or progress into more senior roles.

BSc Nutrition and Dietetics Degree at University of Surrey following my A Levels, graduating in 1996

Worked for 2 years as a clinical dietitian in Oxford, carrying out research identifying levels of malnutrition.

I joined a medical nutrition company, co-ordinating research studies and trials for prescribed medical nutrition feeds and supplements

I undertook freelance work writing medical nutrition articles, specialist updates and supporting UK wide malnutrition projects.

I returned to the NHS, working as a GI dietitian, setting up and leading specialist services. I also co-ordinate training our dietetic students.

I now lead on Education and Training for the dietetic department part time, whilst also undertaking a small amount of private clinical dietetic work.

A career in **Dietetics** is a rewarding and vital profession focused on promoting and maintaining good health through nutrition and dietary choices. Dietitians are experts in food and nutrition who in a clinical setting provide evidence-based guidance on healthy eating and lifestyle choices. Dietitians typically hold a bachelor's degree in dietetics, nutrition, or a related field. You will need to have strong communication skills to effectively counsel and educate patients, analytical skills to assess and interpret nutritional data, empathy and patience to work with individuals with diverse needs and knowledge of the latest research and developments in nutrition science.
