The Accounts/Finance Assistant Level 2 apprenticeship is an excellent skills development opportunity to begin a career in Finance. Apprentices in accounting and finance roles typically assist with various tasks within their department such as processing invoices, reconciling accounts, assisting payroll, managing expenses, and supporting the preparation of financial reports. You will therefore develop on and off the job an awareness of financial law, understanding various legal entities and organisational structures and an understanding of how financial systems work
